Criteria for the Institute Award for Excellence in Ph.D. Research

The following criteria are recommended for selection of the recipient of the Institute Award for Excellence in Ph.D. research.

- The faculty will be nominating graduating/recently graduated Ph.D. student from his/her group to be considered for the award.
- The application will be assessed on the basis of the following elements with weightage as indicated in the table:

S. No.	Element	Weightage
a.	Comments of both reviewers and their recommendation for the best thesis award	25%
b.	Recommendation of the examiners during Ph.D. thesis defence for the best thesis award	15%
c.	Publications in Journals listed in SCI expanded database	40%
d.	Patents	15%
e.	Publications in Journals not listed in SCI expanded database + Conference presentations	5%

- Overall score for each student will be determined, and the award will be given to the highest scorer.
