Acceptance notification will be communicated to authors with a request to submit the soft copy of final abstract in camera ready form by ~~December 15, 2018~~ December 28, 2018. Preference will be given to papers which deal with recent advancements, applications and developments in the aforesaid thematic areas. All papers submitted for presentation in the conference must be original and should not have been presented elsewhere. All papers will be subjected to review and decisions will be conveyed to the authors accordingly.
